

Youth Handgun Safety Act

ATF

- (1) The misuse of handguns is a leading contributor to juvenile violence and fatalities.
- Safely storing and securing firearms away from children will help accidents, and save lives. prevent the unlawful possession of handguns by juveniles, stop
- (3) Federal law prohibits, except in certain limited circumstances, anyone a person under 18. person from selling, delivering, or otherwise transferring a handgun to under 18 years of age from knowingly possessing a handgun, or any
- 4 A knowing violation of the prohibition against selling, delivering, or under certain circumstances, punishable by up to 10 years in prison. otherwise transferring a handgun to a person under the age of 18 is,
